Compare costs of membership fees, group discounts, and licensing agreements for databases. Investigate whether or not LibSys5 could join as a system. Make a recommendation on the best alternative. Investigate Portico and LOCKSS (Lots of Copies Keep Stuff Safe) as a means of post-cancellation access by acquiring content instead of leasing it as part of a collection management strategy.
